

# Meet ALICE<sup>®</sup>

Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed

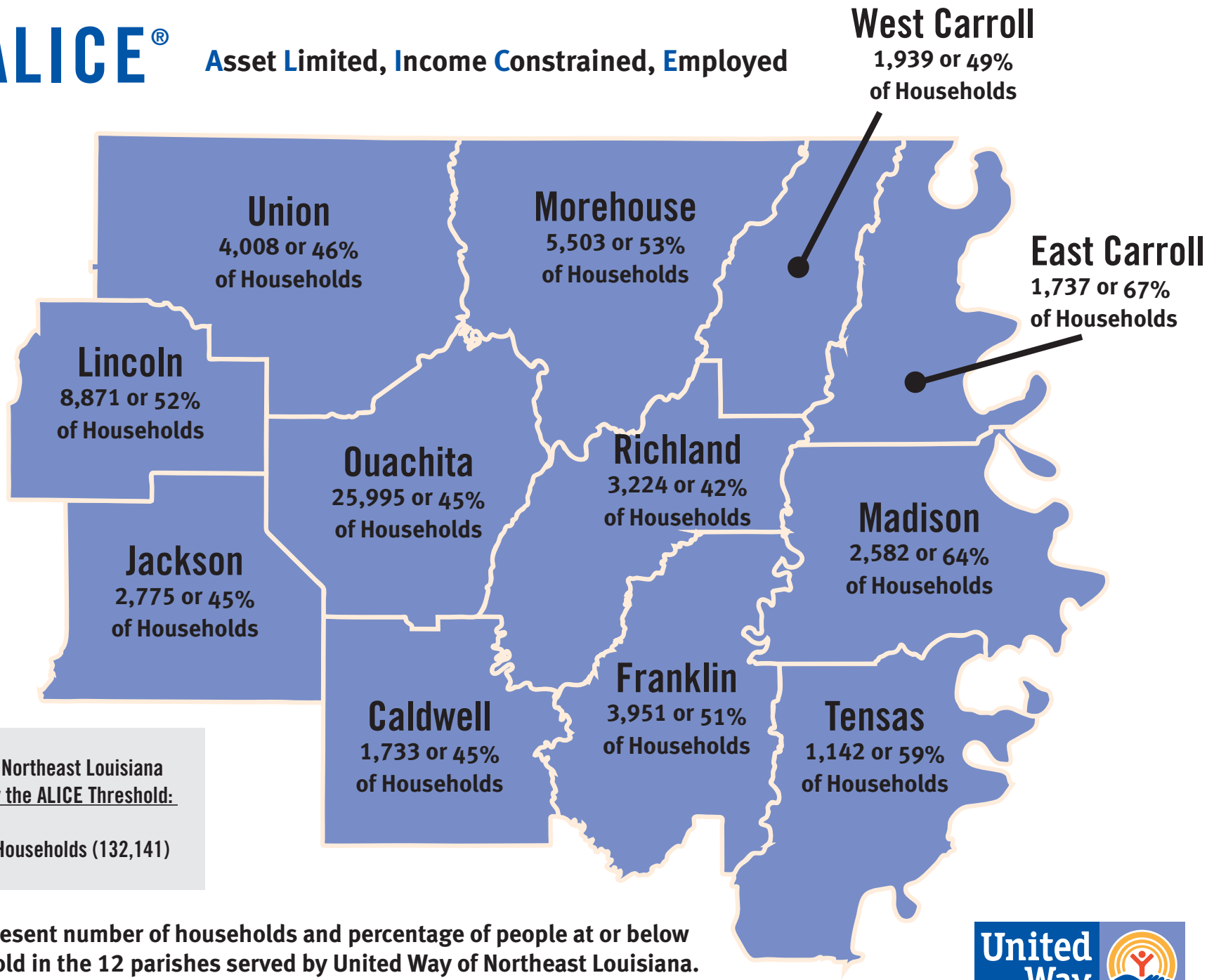
The United Way ALICE Report for Louisiana, updated April 2017, finds that 42 percent of Louisiana's households are struggling to afford the state's cost of living.

In Northeast Louisiana, that number is 48%.

The study focuses on a group of people who are employed, work at low-paying jobs, have little or no savings, and are one emergency away from falling into poverty.

Total households in Northeast Louisiana that are at or below the ALICE Threshold:

63,460 or 48% of Households (132,141)
