FINANCIAL HEALTH SERVICES

VITA

The VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) program offers free tax preparation and e-filing services to qualifying individuals and families. VITA services are a reliable and trusted source for preparing tax returns. VITA tax preparers are trained and certified by the IRS.

BANK ON -

BankOn NELA is a collaborative coalition comprising financial institutions, community organizations, and government agencies. Its mission is to enhance the financial stability of unbanked and underbanked residents in our communities. This is achieved through connecting them to secure and affordable mainstream accounts in banks and credit unions, while also raising public awareness and expanding access to financial education and empowerment opportunities.

FINANCIAL COUNSELING

Financial counselors help individuals deal with financial topics like budgeting, debt, and saving. Financial counselors also help participants understand their current financial situation, set goals, manage money, and plan for a future.

DOLLARS & \$ENSE -

United Way NELA's Dollars & \$ense is a financial education simulation through which young people actively learn how to make better financial decisions and

gain knowledge of budgeting, saving, and spending.

THE HEIRSHIP PROJECT

The Heirship Project provides education, outreach, and support to those with heir property and title issues. Obtaining proof of ownership allows individuals to apply for recovery funds and personally secure their property for the future.
