WHO IS ALICE?

According to the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), **19%** of households in Louisiana (339,916) were in poverty in 2021. Yet United for ALICE data shows that another **32%** (562,552 households) were ALICE. ALICE households earn above the FPL, but not enough to afford the basics in the communities where they live.

The reality is that of the 1,776,260 households in Louisiana, **902,468 - 51%** - had income below the ALICE Threshold of Financial Survival in 2021, the second-highest rate in the U.S.
